

**A NEW SINGLE NUCLEOTIDE POLYMORPHISM AND ONE – ALLELE SYSTEM FOR NLAIII-RELP IN  
EXON 6 OF LIVIN GENE**

Livin is a member of the inhibitor apoptosis protein and overexpressed in a variety of Solid tumors and cancer cell lines, but its expression and clinical relevance are unclear. As exon 6 of the *gene showed a new NlaIII -RFLP, single nucleotide polymorphism, within codon 248 in one* Philippine, allele frequencies of *NlaIII -248* polymorphism were studied in 200 chromosomes from 100 unrelated normal Korean individuals. As a result, only one allele system, the absence of the *NlaIII 248* site, was detected in Koreans.
